2016 brought further political developments (Brexit, Trump) that confirmed the observations from recent years that rightwing populism grows stronger thanks to its ability to channel the frustrations of voters who are not among the winners of globalisation. In the West we can observe a turn of many blue collar workers towards radical, anti-establishment, xenophobic political movements.

This concerns mainly formerly industrial regions, where the disappointment and anger towards political elites can be linked to the disappearance of good quality jobs in industry. This process is also connected to the shrinking base of traditional leftist parties.
